

GOSPEL Luke 2:1-20

Each time the reader announces To us is born a Savior, *the assembly responds:* **Jesus Christ our Lord**.

Our Christmas Eve story comes from the Gospel of Luke.

In those days a decree went out from Emperor Augustus that all the world should be registered. This was the first registration and was taken while Quirinius was governor of Syria. All went to their own towns to be registered. To us is born a Savior.




