

P Let us confess our sin in the presence of God and of one another.


Most merciful God,


### SECOND READING: 1 Corinthians 10: 1-13





#### THE LORD'S PRAYER


P Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us.




#### **COMMUNION**
